20. **Nuclear Ban Treaty – A proposal from Councillor Dunford :** 'Heptonstall Parish Council declares its support for the United Nations Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (TPNW), an historic treaty which in January 2021 entered international law. The treaty will result in the complete prohibition of developing, testing and using nuclear weapons.
Heptonstall Parish Council recognises the threat posed to this planet and its people by the continued existence of nuclear weapons and that the Council's residents have a right to live without this threat.
Consequently, Council recognises the necessity of creating a nuclear weapons-free world and regrets the United Kingdom government's refusal so far to sign, ratify or support this landmark treaty.
In adopting this resolution, Council calls on the United Kingdom government to work for a nuclear weapons-free world by:
Signing and ratifying the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons, thereby joining most countries which are committed to nuclear disarmament.
. Playing a leading international role in using its available diplomatic avenues to secure global nuclear disarmament

This Council requests the Clerk to write to the UK Government to inform them of this resolution and to urge them to take account of it.'
